supports participants to contribute to effective **professional development** linked to **teaching, curriculum and assessment** and design and implement **literacy improvement strategies**.



Leading improvement in Literacy: Programme Content and Structure

All our NPQs begin with an introduction to our approach to capacity development and managing improvement through implementation. This approach is then embedded throughout the duration of the programme.

You will work through the three layers of influence:

1. developing mastery of relevant expertise;
2. developing the knowledge and tools to develop others; and
3. extend your influence across a school, department, or Trust.

Each of our NPQ Programmes includes:

- An introduction and diagnostic assessment to identify knowledge gaps in and areas that are most relevant to you.

- Lots of online evidence and examples to introduce you to key ideas and demonstrate how you could implement these concepts.
- A micro implementation task to reinforce the overall approach to managing improvement and to prepare you for the summative assessment.
- Two face-to-face training days and facilitated online training where you will learn through expert-led dialogue, collaborative activities and structured practice of new techniques.
- A formative assessment activity to check your understanding and confidence, signpost you towards further learning and provide feedback that is individual to you.
