National Professional Qualification for Leading Teacher Development - NPQLTD

Designed for school leaders who have, or aspire to have, responsibilities for leading the development of other teachers in their school.

Leaders working in this type of role face multiple challenges: they may indirectly **manage a team** of mentors or coaches, perhaps support ITT, Early Career Teachers and/or wider **professional development** of colleagues within a school. They require expertise across several specialist areas a thorough understanding of the pupils and colleagues they work with to ensure they thrive.

The **NPQLTD** curriculum enables individuals to respond to challenges possibly encountered in their role, provides a network, and access to continuous debate to ensure educational growth and development. 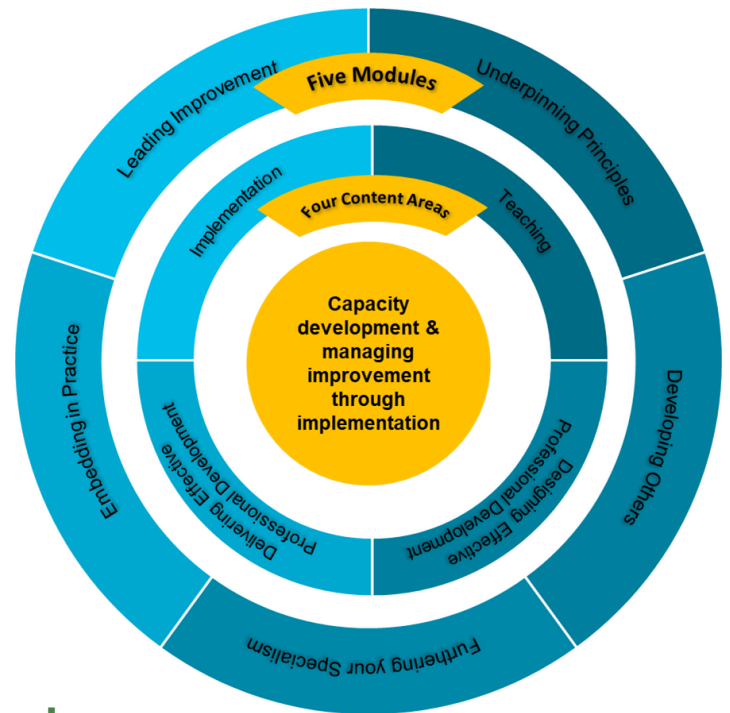

- A formative assessment activity to check your understanding and confidence, signpost you towards further learning and provide feedback that is individual to you.
